RECRUITMENT OF ASSTT. SUB-INSPECTORS (FINGER PRINT) IN DELHI POLICE-2012

Applications are invited from Indian Nationals to fill up 21 vacant posts of Asstt. Sub.-Inspectors (Finger Print) in Delhi Police under the following categories in the pay scale of PB-1 ₹ 5200-20200/- + Grade Pay ₹ 2800/- and other allowances as admissible. Recruitment will be held at Delhi for which candidates from all parts of the country fulfilling eligibility conditions are eligible to apply:-

Note:- The personnel of Central Para Military Forces are not eligible to apply under Ex-Servicemen category.

2. CLOSING DATE:

The last date of receipt of application form will be 23.11.2012. Applications received thereafter will not be entertained.

3. ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:

a) **NATIONALITY:** Applicant should be a bonafide citizen of India.

b) EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:

Graduate in Science with Physics or Chemistry or Maths or Zoology or Anthropology.

Or

Higher Secondary (10+2) with Science/Maths and having served for 3 years in any Finger Print Bureau.

Or

C.F.S.L. or F.S.L. personnel dealing with the science of Finger Prints or Single Digit Section of C.R.O.

Or

Serving Head Constables of Single Digit Section of Finger Print Bureau with at least 5 years service in the grade & 2 years experience of the trade.

c) **AGE:** Age: 18 to 25 years as on 01.07.2012 i.e. those born not earlier than 02.07.1994 and not later than 01.07.1987 will be eligible. The upper age limit as prescribed above will be relaxable only in the following cases:-

(i) 28 years for OBC candidates. This relaxation is admissible for those castes notified in the Central List and the List issued by the Govt. of NCT of Delhi. No other certificate will be accepted as sufficient proof.

(ii) 30 years for SC/ST candidates.

(iii) 40, 43 and 45 years for Genl., OBC and SC/ST departmental candidates respectively. A "departmental candidate" means who has rendered a minimum 3 years regular and continuous service in Delhi Police.

(iv) 35 years (38 years for OBC and 40 years for SC/STs) for widows/divorced women/women judicially separated from their husband and who are not re-marrried.

(v) Upto a maximum of 5 years for sportsmen/sportswomen of distinction who have represented a state at the national level and the country at the international level in sports. The discipline of sports for which relaxation is permissible as per table given at Annexure 'A'. If a candidate belongs to SC/ST category and fulfills the above criteria, he/she is eligible for 5 years relaxation in upper age limit over and above the relaxation prescribed at Clause (ii). In effect, he/she qualifies for relaxation in the upper age limit to a maximum of 10 years.

(vi) Age concession to Ex-Servicemen will be allowed in accordance with the orders issued by the government from time to time. They will be permitted to deduct the period served in the armed forces from their actual age and the resultant age, so derived, should not exceed the prescribed age limit by more than three years. It is further clarified that an "Ex-Serviceman" means a person, who has served in any rank whether as a combatant or non-combatant in Army, Navy or Air Force of the Indian Union and who retired from such service after earning his pension. The word "Ex Serviceman" should be recorded/Stamped by the competent authority on the discharge book.

4. STANDARD OF PHYSICAL MEASUREMENT

(I) HEIGHT:

(i) **Male candidates:** 165 cms, relaxable by 5 cms for:-

(a) Residents of hill areas i.e. Garhwalis, Kumaonis, Gorkhas, Dogras, Marathas and candidates belonging to states of Sikkim, Nagaland, Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Tripura, Mizoram, Meghalaya, Assam, Himachal Pradesh, Kashmir and Leh & Ladakh regions of J&K (Candidates claiming this relaxation would have to produce a certificate to this effect (Hill Area Certificate) from the competent authority i.e. DC/DM/SDM or Tehsildar of their place of residence at the time of Physical Measurement Test).

(b) ST candidates.

(ii) **Female candidates:** 157 cms, relaxable by 5 cms for:-

(a) Residents of hill areas for which certificates as above (Hill Area Certificate) will be produced.

(b) SC/ST Candidates.

(II) CHEST: (Male candidates)

Minimum 78 cms to 82 cms, relaxable by 5 cms for:-

(a) Residents of hill areas for which certificates as above (Hill Area Certificate) will be produced.

(b) ST Candidates.

Note:- For all candidates minimum expansion has to be 4 cms., falling which he will be disqualified.

5. MEDICAL STANDARD

The candidates should be of sound health, free from defect, deformity or disease. Both eyes should have a vision 6/12 with or without glasses. No relaxation is allowed to any category of candidates on this count.

7. DOCUMENT TO BE ATTACHED WITH THE APPLICATION FORMS.

- a. A Demand/Bank Draft/Banker's cheque of ₹ 100/- should be attached as fee in favour of DCP/Recruitment Cell, New Police Lines, Delhi (payable at Delhi) which should be valid for three months. The application fee for SC/ST and Ex-Servicemen candidates is exempted.
- b. Self addressed envelop with ₹ 5/- stamp. Candidates are advised to affix stamp of ₹ 25/- (Rupees twenty five only) if they desire that call letter for PE&MT is to be sent by Regd. Post, Delhi Police will not accept responsibility for postal delay.
- c. Attested copies of all documents/certificates pertaining to age, education, experience, caste, hill areas, NOC/discharge certificate (in case of Ex-Servicemen), sports certificate, proof to avail age relaxation as a widow/divorced/judicially separated women alongwith application form.

Duly filled-in application forms alongwith required documents should be sent through ordinary post to "Post Box No. 8020, Delhi-110033" and write on the top of the envelope "Application for the post of Assistant Sub-Inspectors (Finger Print) in Delhi Police-2012".

i)	1600 metres Race	07 minutes (Qualifying)	Those who qualify in the race will further appear in the following tests :-
ii)	Long jump	12½ feet (12' 6")	(To be achieved in any one of the three chances that will be given)
iii)	High jump	3½ feet (3' 6")	(-do-)

Note:- There shall be no appeal against disqualification in race, long jump and high jump.

PHYSICAL ENDURANCE TEST ONLY FOR MALE DEPARTMENTAL AND EX-SERVICEMAN CANDIDATES (AGE-WISE) WILL BE AS UNDER:-

i) Race - 1600 metres (Qualifying):-

Age-wise
From the age of above 30 & upto 40 years 08 minutes
From the age of 40 years and above 09 minutes

ii) Long jump:-

Age-wise
From the age of above 30 & upto 40 years 11½ feet (11' 6") (qualifying in three chances)
From the age of 40 years and above 10½ feet (10' 6") (qualifying in three chances)

iii) High jump:-

Age-wise
From the age of above 30 & upto 40 years 3¼ feet (3' 3") (qualifying in three chances)
From the age of 40 years and above 03 feet (qualifying in three chances)

Note:- There shall be no appeal against disqualification in race, long jump and high jump.

(B) PHYSICAL ENDURANCE TEST FOR FEMALE CANDIDATE (QUALIFYING)

i)	800 metres Race	05 minutes (Qualifying)	Those who qualify in the race will further appear in the following tests :-
ii)	Long jump	09 feet	(To be achieved in any one of the three chances that will be given)
iii)	High jump	3 feet	(-do-)

Note:- There shall be no appeal against disqualification in race, long jump and high jump.

PHYSICAL ENDURANCE TEST ONLY FOR FEMALE DEPARTMENTAL CANDIDATES (AGE-WISE) WILL BE AS UNDER:-

i) Race - 800 metres (Qualifying):-

Age-wise
From the age of above 30 & upto 40 years 06 minutes
From the age of 40 years and above 07 minutes

ii) Long jump:-

Age-wise
From the age of above 30 & upto 40 years 8 feet (qualifying in three chances)
From the age of 40 years and above 07 feet (qualifying in three chances)

iii) High jump:-

Age-wise
From the age of above 30 & upto 40 years 2½ feet (2' 6") (qualifying in three chances)
From the age of 40 years and above 2¼ feet (2' 3") (qualifying in three chances)

Note:- There shall be no appeal against disqualification in race, long jump and high jump.

9. WRITTEN TEST

All candidates, who qualify the physical endurance & measurement tests, shall be put through a written test. The paper shall be of 1 ½ (one and half hour) duration and shall carry 100 marks. The paper shall be of an objective type and include questions on General Knowledge/Awareness (25 marks), Arithmetic (25 marks), English (25 marks) and General Science (25 marks). The question paper of General Knowledge/Awareness, Arithmetic and General Science will be bilingual (English and Hindi).

10. INTERVIEW

Successful candidates (depending upon the number of vacancies) shall be called to appear before the Selection Board for interview. The interview will be of 10 marks.

11. FINAL RESULT

The final result will be prepared on the basis of marks obtained in the written test (100 marks) and interview (10 marks).

12. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- i) Application forms will be rejected if these are :-
 - a) Incomplete.
 - b) Without Demand/Bank Draft/banker's cheque of ₹ 100/-.
 - c) Received in duplicate.
 - d) Without attested copy of caste certificate in case of SC/ST and discharge book in case of Ex-Servicemen for fee exemption.
 - e) Without photograph.

- f) Application form not signed by the candidate.
- g) Without required attested copies of documents.
- ii) 10% vacancies are reserved for Ex-servicemen as per GOI's instructions.
- iii) Candidates seeking relaxation in height and chest will have to produce relevant original documents at the time of physical measurement.
- iv) Candidates belonging to OBC category of area other than Delhi shall have to produce OBC certificate on the prescribed format required for appointment to posts under the Govt. of India.
- v) Scrutiny of documents will be conducted at the time of the interview. Candidates not in possession of required/valid documents i.e. age, education, caste certificate, discharge certificate in r/o ex-serviceman at the time of submission of application form shall be disqualified for interview.
- vi) If ineligibility of a candidate is detected at any stage, his/her candidature will be cancelled without any prior notice.
- vii) If there is any variation in the interpretation of words/instructions, the English version will prevail and the decision of Police Headquarters will be final.
- viii) Candidates already working with Govt. can apply after intimating to their Head of Office/ Department and need not send another copy through proper channel. An undertaking to this effect may be enclosed with the application form. They will have to provide N.O.C. from their department at the time of checking of documents.
- ix) The candidate must be sure of his/her height, chest and educational qualification, which should conform to the minimum standards laid down.
