The National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) invites applications for the award of Post Doctoral Fellowships (PDF) and Project Assistants (PA). The objective of this award is to provide an opportunity for young researchers with an outstanding academic record, to undertake systemic research on Assessment and Accreditation of institutions of higher education through the large pool of data available with NAAC. The candidates are expected to look into Quality Evaluation, Benchmarking, Best Practices and Total Quality Management and other issues pertaining to quality assurance, quality sustenance and quality enhancement in institutions.

Post Doctoral Fellowships (PDF) - Candidates below the age of 40 years who have obtained their Ph.D. degree in Social Sciences/ Humanities and Sciences with strong base in statistics and ICT are preferred.
