Professor: A minimum of 10 years teaching/research/professional experience of which at least 4 years should be at the level of Associate Professor in an academic institution or equivalent position in a research organization or industry as on the date of application. The candidate should have demonstrated leadership in research in a specific area of specialization in terms of guidance of PhD students, strong record of publications in journals of high impact factor, patents, laboratory/course development and/or other recognized relevant professional activities.

Associate Professor: A minimum of 6 years teaching/research/professional experience of which at least three years should be at the level of Assistant Professor in an academic institution or equivalent position in a research organization or industry as on the date of application. The candidate should have demonstrated adequate experience of independent research in terms of guidance of MTech and PhD students, strong record of publications in journals of high impact factor, patents, laboratory/course development and/or other recognized relevant professional activities.

Assistant Professor: Ph.D., with three or more years of teaching/research/professional experience excluding the experience gained while pursuing PhD. The candidates should

have demonstrated strong research capabilities in terms of publications in reputed journals of high impact factor and patents. Period of probation in regular appointment will be one year.

Candidates who do not fulfill the minimum experience requirement may be offered appointment on a contract basis for a period not exceeding three years, depending upon the academic credential. Such offers may be regularized after a peer review.

Reservation: Without any compromise on qualification, experience and competence, reservation as per Government of India (GoI) rules include: 15%, 7.5% and 27% for SCs, STs and OBCs respectively at the entry level positions of Assistant Professor in Science and Technology Departments.
