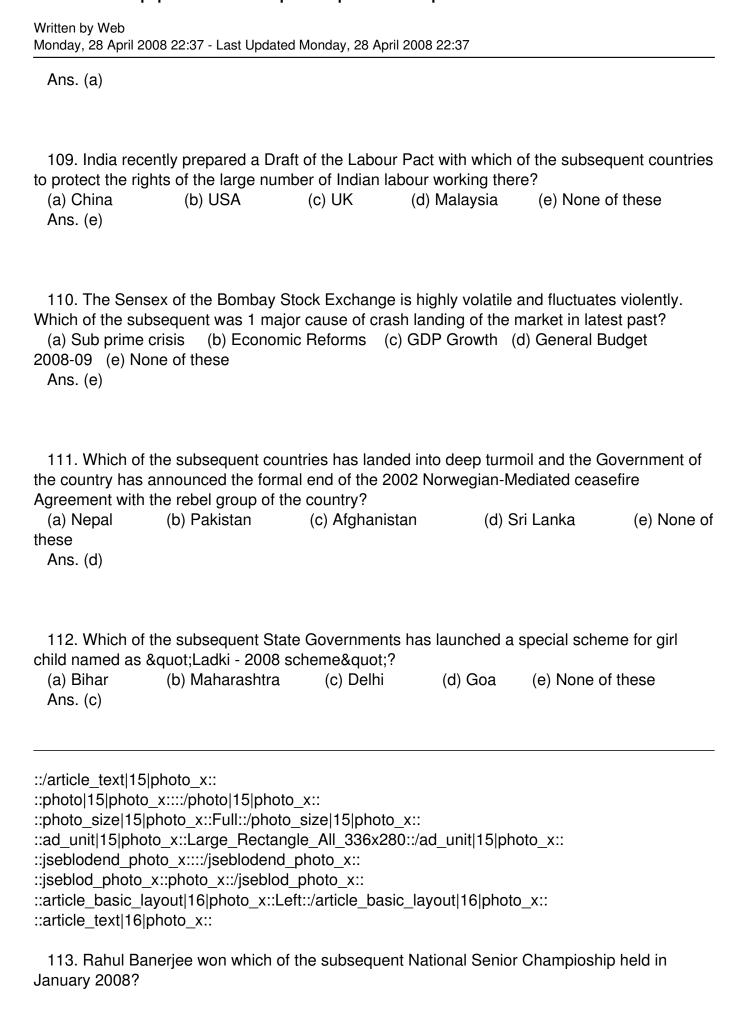

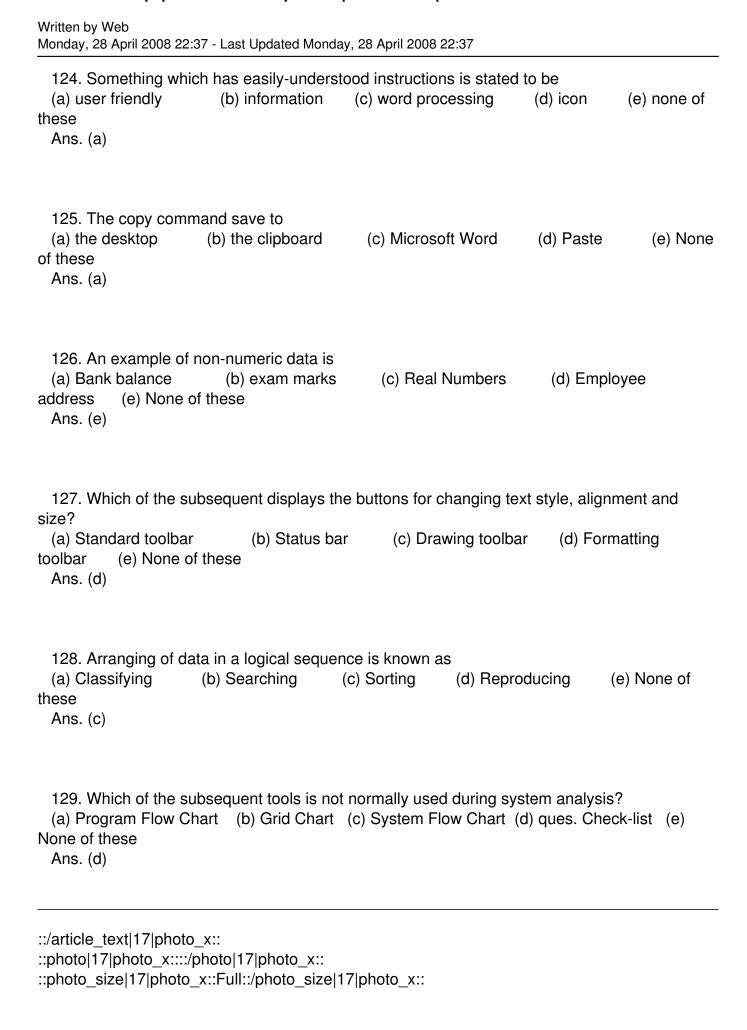

There is absolutely no point in complaining that over the years, there has been pressure for increased productivity and higher earnings for workers in industry. There are several ways for increasing employees' earnings. Employee earnings can be increased by raising the selling price of the firm's products and services, reducing profits or costs of raw materials, or augmenting labour productivity. People may be attracted to join and remain in organisations to receive organisational rewards, but being motivated to join an organisation is not the identical as being motivated to exert effort in an organisation. The challenge to management is to obtain and administer option form of incentives which will induce employees to improve work performance. Such option forms of reinforcement will require increased understanding of motivational theories and programmes


